



GETTING YOUR DRIVERS LICENSE: 6 HOUR ADULT

You must take the following with you in order to get a license.

1. Certificate of Completion (Emailed to you from Secretary of State)
2. \$5.00 check made out to "Secretary of State" (Cost covers Drivers License Fee)
3. Eyeglasses or contact lenses if needed for vision test, written, and road test
4. Social Security Card
5. Certified copy of your birth certificate (must have the official copy of your birth certificate with a raised stamp or colored seal or valid passport).
 - a. If you need a copy of your birth certificate, you must call the county office in which you were born.
6. Two (2) forms of ID showing current address, for example:
 - a. Affidavit-Certificate of Residency (available only at a Drivers Service facility)
 - b. Bank Statement (dated within 90 days prior of application)
 - c. Canceled Check (dated within 90 days prior of application)
 - d. Credit Report
 - e. Certified Grade/High School/College/University Transcript
 - f. Deed, Title, Mortgage, Rental/Lease agreement
 - g. Insurance Policy (homeowner's or renter's)
 - h. Letter on Official School Letterhead (dated within 90 days prior of application)
 - i. Medical Claim or Statement of Benefits (life insurance)
 - j. Official mail received from State, County, City or Village or Federal Government Agency
 - k. Pay Stub or Electronic Deposit
 - l. Pension or Retirement Statement
 - m. Phone Book, produced by a phone publisher
 - n. Report Card from Grade/High School or College/University
 - o. Tuition invoice/official mail from college or university, dated within the 12 months prior to application
 - p. Utility Bill (electric, water, refuse, telephone land/cell, cable or gas, issued within 90 days prior of application)
7. Valid insurance card of road test vehicle
8. Vehicle registration of road test vehicle
9. Bring Drivers Permit (only if you have already completed/passed written test)

*During this time you will complete the vision, written, and road test to obtain an Illinois Drivers License.

**Take all of the above items to your nearest
Secretary of State Driver Services Facility.**
