



GETTING YOUR DRIVERS LICENSE

You must take the following with you in order to get a License.

1. Certificate of Completion (mailed to you from Secretary of State after completion of course)
2. Parent/Guardian Present or Signed Affidavit by Parent/Guardian
3. 50 hour driving log: completed and signed
4. Eyeglasses or contact lenses for vision test (must pass vision test in order to take written test)
5. Social Security Card
6. Certified copy of your birth certificate (must have the official copy of your birth certificate with a raised stamp or colored seal or valid passport).
 - a. If you need a copy of your birth certificate, you must call the county office in which you were born.
7. Two (2) forms of ID showing students name with current address, for example:
 - Affidavit-Certificate of Residency (Available only at a Drivers Service facility)
 - Bank Statement (dated within 90 days prior to application)
 - Canceled Check (dated within 90 days prior to application)
 - Certified High School Transcript
 - Credit Report
 - Deed/Title, Mortgage, Rental/Lease Agreement
 - Insurance Policy (homeowner's or renter's)
 - Letter on Official School Letterhead (dated within 90 days prior to application)
 - Medical Claim or Statement of Benefit (from private insurance company or public agency, dated within 90 days prior to application)
 - Official mail received from a State, County, City or Village or Federal Government agency (must include first and last name of applicant and complete address)
 - Pay Stub or Electronic Deposit Receipt
 - Pension or Retirement Statement
 - Phone Book, produced by a phone book publisher
 - Report Card from Grade/High School/ or College/University
 - Tuition invoice/official mail from college or university, dated within the 12 months prior to application
 - Utility Bill (electric, water, refuse, telephone land/cell, cable or gas, dated within 90 days prior to application)
8. Valid insurance card of road test vehicle
9. Vehicle registration of road test vehicle
10. Copy of Drivers Permit

**Take all of the above items to your nearest
Secretary of State Driver Services Facility.**
